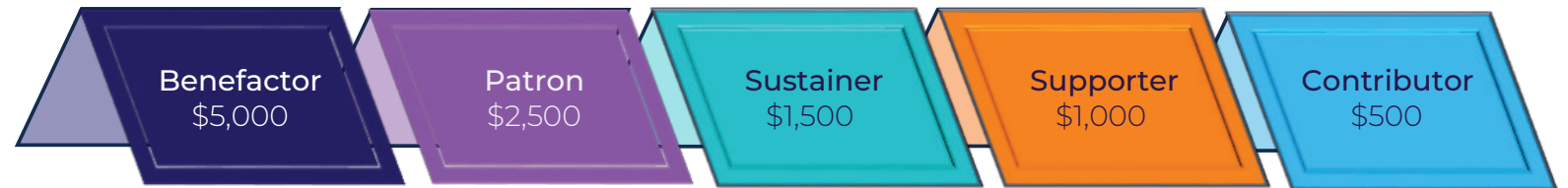




Why Become a Sponsor?

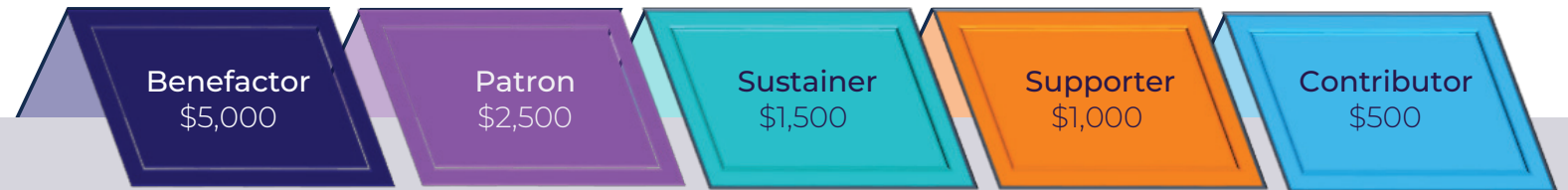


- Sponsorship is an excellent way for your organization to showcase its commitment to plain language and to secure your place as a leader in the culture of clarity in North America.
